

How To Be The Best EA Sports College Football Gamer Checklist

1. Master the Basics

- Learn the Controls: Start with the basics—master the controls and get comfortable with the mechanics of passing, running, and defense. Spend time in practice mode to build muscle memory.
- Understand Playbooks: Explore different playbooks and formations. Understand the strengths and weaknesses of each to effectively outsmart opponents.

2. Know Your Personnel

- Recruit Like a Champ: Focus on recruiting the best players for your system. Prioritize speed, strength, and awareness to build a powerhouse team.
- Player Development: Take time to develop your players. Spend XP wisely on attributes that align with your strategy, such as upgrading your QB's accuracy or improving your defensive line's block-shedding.

- **Clock Management**: Be smart with the clock. Control the tempo of the game, run the ball to chew up time, and make sure to leave no time on the clock for your opponent.
- **Fourth-Down Decisions**: Know when to go for it on fourth down and when to punt. Making the right call can win you the game.

5. Master the Art of Passing and Running

- **QB Awareness**: Keep your eyes on the field and develop great timing with your receivers. Learn how to read defenses quickly to avoid costly interceptions.

- Dynasty Mode: Build a dynasty through relentless recruiting and smart roster management. Develop a long-term strategy to create a powerhouse program year after year.
